New Club Information

Timberline accepts clubs for membership in the Spring of each year for the Fall playing season. TYSA does not allow independent teams to register or play within TYSA's gaming league. Applications for membership as a new club in TYSA must be made no later than the date of TYSA's April Board meeting. The application for membership should provide a brief overview of the history, objectives and mission of the club along with each of the following:

- Constitution and Bylaws
- Evidence of non-profit status, to include state certificate of incorporation, IRS determination letter, and EIN
- List of all club officers with full contact information including address, phone and email contacts.
- A description and location of the club's playing and practice fields.
- A list of club teams by age group. TYSA has a requirement that new clubs register a minimum of 10 teams.
- Name and contact info of referee assignor

As part of its application, each aspiring new club must confirm that it has read, understands and will comply with TYSA and STYSA's (South Texas Youth Soccer Association, TYSA's parent organization) rules and policies.

Any newly accepted club will be accepted for membership as a Provisional Member.
